New shapes, new materials, and a new optimism blossom in post-war America.



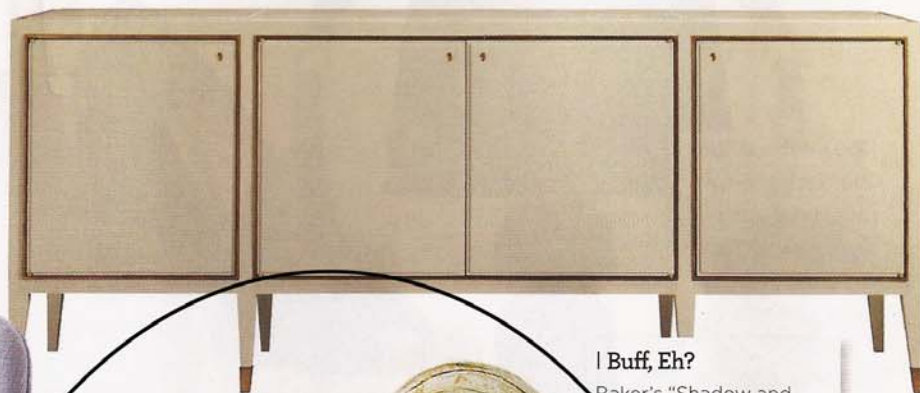
